1	Define the different types of ways we can make 'art'. This could be drawing, painting, mixed paper collage.	Think of the different types of 'art' you would see in a museum. Sculpture? Papier Mache?	Can you make a miniature model of one of the types of Art you have researched and defined?
2	Print off or trace one of Andy Warhol's pictures. Then analyse the picture you have drawn or traced using the 6 formal elements	The 6 formal elements are: Line, tone, shape, colour, pattern and texture.	Can you add textures to your picture? This could be by gluing different types of materials to your image to add texture.
3	Look, cover and write the words: <i>Clay, modelling, acrylic, painting, designing, Onomatopoeia, Roy Lichtenstein, Andy Warhol, Keith Haring</i>	Remember that design doesn't have an H! This is a common mistake when spelling this word	Can you give a definition for each of the words? Or can you print a picture of each of the artists' work?
4	Write a paragraph that explains why Pop Art became so popular after the war. Why did people want to see powerful and colourful imagery?	Imagine how the country felt after the war. Probably sad and trying hard to get their lives back on track! Why might pop art have helped?	Make a pop art poster that might have been used after the war. What might it say to help list the spirits of the nation?
5	Write a paragraph that explains the types of colours pop art uses. Explain why they use these colours.	How do bold and bright colours make you feel?	Find out what different colours symbolise. For example, red often means danger.
