1	To write a diary entry of a bullying victim. How would they feel? What do you think of the bully?	Remember SPAG!	What words would you use to express how you feel? Mind map these before you write your diary entry
2	Write a diary entry as if you were the bully. How is it going to differ from the entry of the victim? Ensure you check your SPAG	How would the bully feel? Empowered? Or would the bully feel like they are being bullied?	Mind map your words before you write the diary entry. What words would you use?
3	Create a thought tunnel diagram based on what you performed in this week's lesson. What advice did people give you? Write it down	What advice would you have given yourself?	Define what a thought tunnel is.
4	Create a leaflet which advises people what to do if they are being bullied. Who would you talk to? What could you do?	There are plenty of anti-bullying websites online. Use these to help you.	Include a story of someone who has successfully overcome bullying. Use this to uplift the reader.
